**The Saco-Swift Rivers Local Advisory Committee's (SSRLAC) will hold a meeting on December 19, 2019 in the Annex Conference Room of the Saco Ranger District Headquarters in Conway, New Hampshire. The SSRLAC represents stakeholder communities within the state designated Swift and Saco River corridors and its meetings are open to the public. The responsibilities of the Local Advisory Committee outlined by NDHES are as follows:**

(a) To advise the commissioner, the advisory committee (Rivers Management Advisory Committee), the municipalities through which the Designated River or segment flows, the municipalities within tributary drainage areas on matters pertaining to the management of the river or segment and tributary drainage areas.

(b) To consider and comment on any federal, state, or local governmental plans to approve license, fund or construct facilities that would alter the resource values and characteristics for which the river or segment is designated.

(c) To develop or assist in the development and adoption of local river corridor management plans. The local planning board may adopt such plans as an adjunct to their local master plan.

(d) To report biennially to the Rivers Management Advisory Committee and the commissioner, and annually to municipalities on the status of compliance with federal and state laws and regulations, local ordinances, and plans relevant to the Designated River or segment, its corridor, and tributary drainage areas. NDHES offers the committee technical assistance in developing and implementing the management plan.
