MINUTES**

Dick Ludders, Chair, called the meeting, conducted via Zoom conference call, to order at 6:32 PM under the emergency provisions of RSA 91-A, New Hampshire's Right-to-Know law, as allowed by Emergency Order 11 under Executive Order 2020-04 in light of the COVID-19 outbreak. MINUTES:

PERMIT APPLICATION REVIEWS

2020-01981 Shoreland Permit; 178 Elm St., Goffstown; Mitigation of stormwater runoff to Glen Lake (Piscataquog River)

This is an after-the-fact application because the property owner started construction of a "fix" for an erosion problem but then halted construction to obtain professional design assistance from GeoInsight. The design now proposed includes a plunge pool which is critical to both absorb the energy of the runoff stream and collect sediment that would otherwise go in the lake. The PRLAC recognizes the importance of the design of this feature and recommends the NHDES review include the following:

- The proposed infiltration pond (plunge pool) shall be installed and maintained to effectively absorb and infiltrate stormwater to ensure compliance with RSA 483-B:9,V,(g)
- Photographs documenting the construction of the proposed infiltration pond (plunge pool) shall be submitted to NHDES

2020-01801 Wetlands Permit; 35 Bay St. Goffstown; Repair shorewall collapse; Glen Lake
The plan submitted with the application is just a sketch. Additional design detail should be provided to NHDES to confirm the following:

- An effective coffer or silt dam design that will allow the restoration work to be done in the dry with all mechanized equipment working from the land side.
- The provision of a stable footing for the wall and steps with minimal impact to the lake bed.

CORRESPONDENCE/GENERAL DISCUSSION:

Andy reported the Goffstown Select Board has created the "Village-Piscataquog River Pedestrian Bridge AdHoc Committee" to undertake a one year study to explore the possibility of constructing a bridge on the site of the former railroad bridge that would link the end of the rail/trail with the village. Andy and Alan will keep the PRLAC advised of the progress of this and any support we might offer.
